4. Financial report and February is BHB Funding application Month—Sean/Christina/Jim and board member travel report approval--Board (**Action Item**): Funding application available February for project activities. 6. Wraparound Intensive Care Coordination (BPA Health)—Adisson Roylance: Adisson provided information about the Wraparound program that is being offered throughout the state. 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7. ID Resilience Projects--Resilience Trainings—Katie Francis: Katie Francis and Hailey Clements discussed the trainings available through their program. They focus on trauma informed resources. They are offering free trainings with a variety of different topics. They are focusing on organizations, schools and non-profits.
8. Magellan Crisis Collaborative meeting in Dec—report from BHB members who attended: Sara Bennett reviewed the various datapoints that were provided from the crisis system of care. Information was provided from 988, mobil crisis and crisis center.
9. Point in time homeless count—Michelle King: Michelle was unable to attend our meeting, Jim provided information for Michelle-- The count is January 29th and they are looking for volunteers. Volunteers can connect with Michelle King.
10. LC Valley Youth Resource Center & Youth Village update—Michelle King: The Youth Village was approved by the Lewiston City Council with the deciding vote by Major Johnson. Michelle will provide further information at the next meeting.
11. Legislative update—Tom/Chris/Jim: Tom is no longer on the legislative committee. Sheriff Chris Goetz is the IAC legislative committee and will attend meetings to provide information in the future. Monday the legislature convened for the 2025 session. There are efforts to overturn Medicaid expansion. The priorities have been sent out to our regional representatives.
12. Recovery Community Center Latah/Nez Perce/Lewis Counties—Shaun/Astahna/Amber: Amber reported in December 164 people were served. Amber has developed a report on all their efforts this past year that is available. Latah and Nez Perce Recovery centers were not present.
