There were no apparent findings. Darrel reported that eh thought it was a friendly meeting.</p> <p>The FY20 plan and budget have been submitted. Waiting on approval.</p> <p>PFS strategy updates: Be the Parents media is running smoothly. We have had 8 schools register to participate in the prom/graduation stipends. IDFY scholarships are open. Karen Ashenbrenner is leading the recruitment; she states that registrations don't typically start until the end of the school year. DITEP training had 12 participants. Strengthening Families facilitators training had 14 participants out of 21 who registered. Tammy L. reported the class was great and that she plans to send more participants from the Recovery Center to the Region 1 training. Approximately 300 DeTerra pouches have been given out. The group continues to work on the plan for the free mental health screenings to begin FY20. The hope is that there will be 2 free screening days each month spread out throughout the region. Sharlene met with Neighborhood All Stars on the two media campaigns currently being worked on by the group. They will begin design next week.</p> <p>The group approved the Opioid Coalition Action Plan draft.</p> <p>The only coalition present was Upriver Youth Leadership Council. They reported they recently held their Appreciation Dinner and had 150 attendees. Sharlene will present Jim with the award at the next BHB meeting. They held a Vaping Town Hall with good attendance. Their Youth Advisory Board continues to plan healthy activities for their peers and for families, as well as doing community service projects.</p>
