The Corp is willing to store individual's personal items. The Recovery Center distributes food bags to homeless camps. These camps are located under the bridge, east side, Gun Club road and along the rivers. LPD has 2 officers who ride around downtown Lewiston on the dikes. NPC contributed \$20,000.</li> </ul>
