 - Shaun Hollis reported from CWC Recovery Center. On March 1st there will be a house opening up for sober living. Shaun reported that he has met with the landlord who purchased a 4 bedroom house. The house is located past IGA on the hillside. Shaun is in conversation with the city and county in order to structure the house for sober living.
 - Jackie Sayer reported there will probably be additional funds for COVID housing relief. There are vouchers set aside for those being released from an institution, i.e. State Hospital, jail. Person who report that they're disabled could qualify. They would need to see a provider who would provide documentation to support their disability.
 - Suzanne Johnson asked if anyone has heard of statewide or local concern regarding the lifting the moratorium for rent payments to landlords.
 - Question was asked if there are any statistics of people who are homeless and the costs involved? If Jackie is able to come up with stats, she'll provide them to this committee.
