- Welcome, and Introductions: Dorothy Pollman, Lisa Martin, Michelle King, and Shaun Hollis
- **Motion:** To approve the minutes from May 2022 meeting. Michelle made a motion to pass May 2022 minutes and Dorothy seconded.

- Update on Sober Living Grant - Shaun Hollis
Shaun reported that they're waiting until the house is available in Orofino, hoping that this will help in CWC. After it opens there will then be both a female and male house.
 - Dorothy stated that the Treatment Courts will benefit from the additional house.
 - Shaun purchased a single wide trailer located near the Potlach Mill. Looking at opening it up for males. There are 2 RV spots on the property. This would probably be open up for either older or newer RV's.

- Update on contact with Laura Von Tersch, City of Lewiston and Barb Leachman at Community Action – Cara Snyder-

- Update on Union Gospel Mission (if available) – Frank Wright
Michelle reported that the conditional use permit was approved. Their reason statement is set for Wednesday, 7/13 and within 2 weeks property owners can submit an appeal to City Counsel.

- Update on Homeless Shelter – Michelle King (if available) –
Michelle reported that she resigned from the Adult Resource Center Board and Molly Pollastrini, has assumed the position of the President of the Adult Resource Center, she is also an employee of Disabilities Center NW. She will continue to spearhead a possible homeless shelter.

- Miscellaneous -
Per Michelle – there is a movement to do a city outreach to address the lack of access/availability of drinking water in the community on Sunday's. Last year there were 2 people who passed away in Clarkson due to dehydration. She reported that there is a need for volunteers to pass out water to people
